God's Word is active!

12 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Praying to Partner With God:

Picture a situation, Offer it to God, Allow God to intervene and reshape your expectations. Ask God what does he want to see happen? You might already know his will from by his Word. Don't just release your words receive his heart for the topic...

Praying with Authority:

Prayer is not giving your orders to God, or like making a wish list for Santa.. Prayer is taking the highest level of authority a believer can have to the highest level of authority that exist (God) and partnering with his heart and his word to see God's will established on earth!

14 Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. 15 And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

Positioned to Pray:

Worry should ignite our Prayer Life:

When you are tempted with stress, worry, fear, or anxiety you are receiving two invitations.

1. The enemy is inviting you to become distracted, distraught, angry, and defeated.
2. Jesus is inviting you to bring it to a heavenly father who knows you, sees you, and already has provision waiting for you.

*31 "Therefore **do not worry**, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' 32 For after all these things the Gentiles seek. **For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.** 33 **But seek first the kingdom of God** and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. 34 Therefore **do not worry about tomorrow**, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.*

Matthew 6:31-34 (NKJV)

*6 **Be anxious for nothing**, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.*

*6 Don't be pulled in different directions or worried about a thing. **Be saturated in prayer throughout each day, offering your faith-filled requests before God with overflowing gratitude.** Tell him every detail of your life, 7 then God's wonderful peace that transcends human understanding, will guard your heart and mind through Jesus Christ.*

Prayers of Faith:

Do you believe God to be who he says he is? Prayers are faith request because we believe that God who he says he is. You'll move further away from wishful prayers and into powerful effective faith filled prayers as you discover who God is and how much you mean to him through the Word of God.

*20 And when the disciples saw it, they marveled, saying, "How did the fig tree wither away so soon?" 21 So Jesus answered and said to them, "**Assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt**, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' it will be done. 22 **And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive.**"*

Supernatural Prayer Language:

The Holy Spirit is your prayer partner, he prays perfect prayers on your behalf.

26 Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. 27 Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God. 28 And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.

Pray to God like a Child Talks to his Parent:

Your prayers shouldn't sound like a theological dissertation. He knows the word he wrote it! He knows your heart, he knows your path, and he knows the need you have before you had it. Come in faith and believe. Seek to understand his heart and then rule with him on the topic.

1 Look with wonder at the depth of the Father's marvelous love that he has lavished on us! He has called us and made us his very own beloved children. The reason the world doesn't recognize who we are is that they didn't recognize him. 2 Beloved, we are God's children right now; however, it is not yet apparent what we will become. But we do know that when it is finally made visible, we will be just like him,

for we will see him as he truly is. 3 And all who focus their hope on him will always be purifying themselves, just as Jesus is pure.

1 John 3:1-3 (TPT)

*6 But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, **pray to your Father** who is in the secret place; and your **Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.** 7 And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. For they think that they will be heard for their many words. 8 “Therefore do not be like them. **For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him.***

9 In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.

Speak to the Enemy like a Master would speak to a servant:
